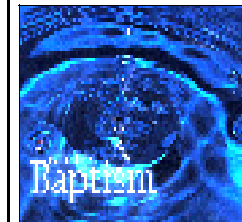

### Matthew 22:34-40

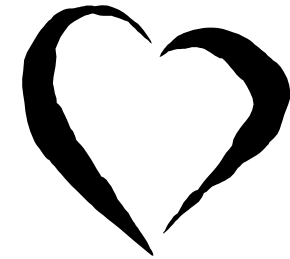
